SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Ilkley & District Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubsport Permit Autotest at: -
The Busfields, Just off Queensway, Guiseley (it will be arrowed). The entrance for the venue is Map Ref 104 195 422.5 on Wednesday 19th June 2019.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MS UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. MSA Permit Number has been issued.
4. The event is open to:
All fully elected members of the organising club.
All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.
Entries are subject to the provisions of M13 for competitors who are age 16 years (or 17 & over without a full RTA Licence).
5. The event is a round of the following IDMC Club Championships:
(I) Clubnight Championship, (J) Ladies Clubnight Championship, (L) Clubmans Autotest Championship, (M) Under 23 Championship, (N) Under 45 Championship, (O) Over 45 Championship, (P) Over 65 Championship, (Q) Semi-Expert Championship, (R) Novice Championship.
6. The programme of the event will be:
Scrutineering will start at 1830 hrs,
The first car will start at 1900 hrs.
Any competitor not signed on by 1900 hrs may be excluded.
7. The event will consist 8 classes as per IDMC Clubnight Classes 2019:
Class 1 – FE FWD Series Production cars upto 1000cc
Class 2 – FE FWD Series Production cars between 1001- 1200cc
Class 3 – FE FWD Series Production cars between 1201cc – 1400cc
Class 4 – FE FWD Series production cars over 1401cc
Class 5 – RWD Series Production cars & Sports Cars
Class 6 – Production Kit Cars, Kit Cars & Specials*
Class 7 – 4WD Series Production cars, to a maximum kerb weight of 1330kg
Class 8 – Rally Cars with an MSA log book.

Class 6 – 8 will be automatically merged if a minimum of 3 entries in either of the classes isn't reached.
A list of definitions for Series Production car / Production Kit car / Kit Car and Sports car can be obtained from the car comps secretary or event secretary.

*A car which does not have a standard body shell, majority of interior trim, seats, glass and does not have running gear, fuel tank or battery in the manufacturers location. Plus any vehicle with a hydraulic handbrake.

The organisers reserve the right to reclassify competitors according to H30.1.3g. All vehicles must comply with MS UK Technical Regulations Section M.

8. Awards will be presented as per "Clubnight Awards 2019".
No competitor may win more than one award.
9. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally on 19th June -7pm.
The entry fee is £8.00 for entries received before the 17th June @ 7.15pm - **Thereafter £15.00.**
All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
A maximum of two entries per vehicle is permitted.

10. The maximum entry for the event is 40. The minimum is 12. The minimum for each class is 3.
Should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

12. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the event.
Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.1 to 5.7.
12. Marking and Penalties will be plus 10 seconds for a "cones/lines" plus 30 seconds for a washout..
13. a) Details of the tests will be notified at the event.
b) Each driver will be allowed one attempt at each test to count for results.
c) Timing will be by hand-held watches.
d) The starting signal will be verbal – cars to start in their own time.
e) Timing will begin when the leading wheels cross forward of the starting line.
f) The order of attempting the tests will be at the organiser's discretion.
g) Practising will not be allowed.
h) Competitors will be identified by scorecards, which will be provided.
14. All other GR's of the MS UK apply as written except:
M17.1 - as the event takes place entirely upon private land, vehicles need not be registered or taxed.
M4.2 - Some markers may be less than 1m in height and can be other than cones.
D14.1 to D14.1.2 & H30.1.1 to 31.1.2 - Entries will be selected in order of receipt by the secretary of the meeting.
15. A Novice is defined as a competitor who has not previously won a class or higher status award on an equivalent or higher status event for which an MS UK permit has been issued.
16. **For competitors wishing to enter on the night the onus is on YOU to check with the secretary of the meeting that the event is running.**
17. Results afterwards will be at the The Ings, Ings Road, Guiseley **LS20 9HR**

Tyres MUST NOT be of a Grip/Town and Country / M&S or All Seasons pattern and may not be of an aggressive type pattern which is considered by the scrutineer to be in appropriate for the type of event and venue.
