2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MS UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. MS UK permit has been applied for.
4. The event is open to:
All fully elected members of the organising club & All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.
Only vehicles recognised as normal series production cars may compete.
Standard tyres as stated in the manufactures handbook.
Vehicles may use diesel or unleaded fuel or be “hybrid”.
THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES ALLOWED IS 12 due to permit restrictions.
5. The entry fee is £8.00 and should be in and paid for by 1915pm on Monday 10th June. Late entries subject to availability can be placed up until Wednesday 12th June at 7.00pm but will be charged a late entry fee of £15.00.
The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event unless a minimum of 6 entries are received by 17.15pm on Monday 10th June.
“For competitors wishing to enter on the night the onus is on YOU to check with the secretary of the meeting that the event is running”.

ECONOMY RUN 2019 ENTRY FORM

THE VEHICLE HAND BOOK MUST BE PRODUCED AT THE START OF THE EVENT

8. The official length of the route will be announced in the final instructions. There will be no need for maps as a fully descriptive road book will be provided. The set average speeds will be 30mph for "A" + "B" and minor roads, 50 mph for motorways. There will be no time schedule to adhere to except at the finish. Route checks may be established at various points and may or may not be named.
9. The start will be between 19.15-19.45hrs. **NO ONE WILL START AFTER THIS TIME**
Maximum time allowed for the 60 mile route is 2 hours.
A route card and start time will be given on completion of signing on. Before the start each car will have its tank filled and tanks refilled to the same level as before at the finish. Measurement will be made to 1/100th of a litre. No allowance will be made for spillage. Competitors will, of course, pay for their fuel. One appointed official will watch the filling of each vehicle and their decision on when a vehicle is "full" of fuel will be final.
10. Assessment of Performance – the standard formula for performance will be used.
11. Ties – if two or more competitors should record the same performance, the competitor with the larger engine will take precedence.
12. Penalties: (Exclusion for)
A – Involvement in any type of accident
B – Successful prosecution by the police.
C – Any alteration to specification of car en route (including tyre pressures)
D – Missing or incorrect information in respect of route check – 10mpg
E – Failure to report to a manned control – 20 mpg
F – Per minute late at finish control – 2 mpg
13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the event at The Hunter's Inn, Pool.
14. Protests – any protests must be lodged in accordance with E8.1.6 and O5 within 30 minutes of the announcement of provisional results.
15. Driving Standards – Drivers must comply at all times with the law, both regarding equipment and traffic rules.
